Wether Trial Results

Grassy Creek is performing at the top end of the merino bloodline comparison based on wether trial results from 2007-2018 we are ranked the 5th best blood line on profit /head and ranked 6th on \$/dse this is based on 73 merino bloodlines. The Grassy Creek bloodline is also a high accuracy bloodline.

Max and Zoe Giles entered a team of wethers in current Bookham wether trial. The ewes are a Bogo base with the ram source being solely Grassy Creek for the last 7 years. They were placed 4th out of the 29 teams which contained 2 stud breeders at 2nd and 3rd. They cut 17% more wool value than the average of the trial also being the heaviest body wt of the first 5 place getters. The Grassy Creek blood team cut 6kg of 16 micron wool with a 68.6 yield also the highest yield out of the first 5 teams. Wool value of \$121.00 the top team had a wool value of \$126.32. Congratulations to Max and Zoe and their classers Simon Flick and Jim Elliot for their hard work.



Tom and Georgie McGuiness of McGuiness Farms won the long wool section of the Crookwell Flock ewe comp and placed 2nd overall they presented a line of 2100 1.5 year old ewes May shorn, these ewes were run at 17.3 dse/ha and cut 50kg of clean wool to the HA the ewes averaged 46kg in body wt. Congratulations to Tom, Georgie and family for presenting a great line of productive ewes in a challenging season and their sheep classer/genetic consultant Craig Wilson.
